## **ALL SENIOR EVENTS ON THURSDAY May 25 AND TUESDAY May 30 REQUIRE MANDATORY ATTENDANCE**

- Thursday May 25 8:30 Senior breakfast - Frankton Christian Church  
10:00 Elementary school - senior walk - wear cap and gown  
10:30 View Senior Slide show and practice commencement  
11:00 Practice commencement with band  
Noon - dismissed for the day - if practice is complete!
- Tuesday May 30 8:30 high school Honors Convocation. **Seniors must arrive by 8:15 to be seated first.**  
10:30 or after awards convo - take final senior picture and practice commencement  
11:30 Senior final walk through high school w/class song
- Friday June 2 7:00 Commencement - **seniors arrive at 6:15** - report to the new gym  
Only seniors and sponsors in new gym - no parents or friends  
After commencement, turn in your gown and pick up your diploma package in the library whenever you are finished visiting in the new gym  
The new gym will be open after commencement as a reception area for parents and guests as long as needed

**\*\*School fees, cafeteria charges, and library fines must be paid before graduation.\*\***

### **Commencement/Baccalaureate Attire**

Consider a trip to Goodwill or Wal-Mart if you don't want to buy expensive stuff.

#### **Boys:**

Dress shirt with collar - any color, but white looks best; no plaids; can be golf shirt

Tie if you want to look your best - black, grey, red, or white

Dress pants - any color or new black jeans

Dress shoes NO ATHLETIC SHOES OR SHOES WITH WHITE BOTTOMS - NO FLIP FLOPS

#### **Girls:**

Dress or skirt and top, or dress pants; or new black jeans; girls do not need a collar

Dress shoes or dress sandals NO ATHLETIC SHOES OR SHOES WITH WHITE BOTTOMS - NO FLIP FLOPS. I would not wear heels. Flats will work best because of the carpeted stairs you will have to walk down.

#### **General info for all:**

Baccalaureate: wear same format as for commencement, but just the gown, not cap or any other cords, or recognitions.

Commencement: wear gown and cap - put the tassel on the right side then you will turn it to the left when you are announced as graduates. **DON'T FORGET YOUR TASSEL!**

Write your name **INSIDE** the cap so you can find it if you throw it.

Don't iron, wash, or put the gown in the dryer - the wrinkles will fall out with body heat and are really less noticeable than you think.

Cords are worn with the highest in importance on the top if you have more than one set.

Medallions will be given graduation night for academic or technical honors diplomas. They are worn on top of all the cords, as they are on a ribbon around the neck.
